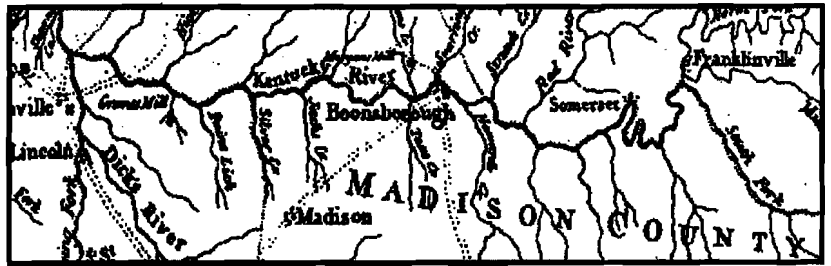


HISTORIC MAP LIBRARIES on CD-ROM



Now you can view old maps on your computer screen enlarged so that you may easily find the locations you seek. Many have been enhanced by computer and manual editing to produce as much readable detail as possible. In many cases, these images are superior to the original maps.

These are maps you can use! You may include them in your publications and on web sites. Map images are in .gif format. Most are designed to print clearly on 8.5x11 inch paper.

[] **THE UNITED STATES AND CANADA BEFORE 1800** A collection of 230 black and white maps showing views of North America at various periods, regions of the U.S. and Canada, and maps of principal cities. Also many battlefield maps and fort diagrams.

[] **EUROPE FROM 1856 TO 1920** A collection of 224 maps (30 in full color) showing countries, regions and individual maps of many cities. This period is particularly important to genealogists because of the large-scale emigration during that time.

[] **THE BRITISH ISLES FROM 1856 TO 1920** A collection of 208 maps including many city plans and excellent full-color county maps. England, Ireland and Scotland are included on this CD.

[] **BRITISH ISLES FROM 3RD CENTURY BC TO 19TH CENTURY AD.** 75 maps, most in color, showing the changes over the past two millenia.

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[] **UNITED STATES TOWN & COUNTY INDEX FOR THE 1887 MAPS.** This 75-page index includes all post offices, railway stations and many other locations including population based on the 1880 census.

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
